

Statement Of Campaign Expenses For Library Trustee Of The

ALBERT WISNER PUBLIC LIBRARY

For Election: April 5, 2016

Chapter 359 of the Laws of 1978 requires that effective September 1, 1978 all candidates for election to the position of Library Trustee of a Public Library shall file sworn statements of campaign expenses.

The filing must set forth all monies or other valuable things which have been paid, given, expended or promised or which have been incurred for or on behalf with his/her approval by any person, firm, association or corporation for the purpose of aiding in his nomination or election or to defeat any other candidate in the election.

Every candidate must file. An itemization is necessary if expenditures exceed \$500.00. When the candidate's only expenditures were for personal expenses which, when taken together with the total expenditures incurred by others on his behalf and with his approval are under \$500.00 a sworn statement must be filed indicating that his election expenditures did not exceed \$500.00.
